Submissions that are being considered by another journal or by a publisher are not accepted. Authors receive five complimentary copies of the issue in which their work appears.

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For a long time, the editors of *Mester* have desired to dedicate one issue each year to articles focusing on a single topic. Professor Joaquín Gimeno Casalduero's seminar on *Los Milagros de Nuestra Señora* by Gonzalo de Berceo, given during the fall quarter of 1987, provided us with the opportunity to initiate this policy. The first four articles presented are the product of this seminar. These articles were the catalyst for our current issue dedicated to medieval literature of the Iberian peninsula.
