The Museum of Anthropology, CSU, Bakersfield, seeks to publish monograph-length papers in any of the subfields in Anthropology dealing with subjects from anywhere in the world (California materials are especially desired). The *Papers* series is published on an occasional basis, depending upon the submission of manuscripts. Submissions will be reviewed internally by the Museum editorial staff, who may seek the advice of outside experts.

Authors must submit three copies of the typescript to the editor for review. The paper should generally follow the style of the *Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology*; if there are too many variations from that style, the paper will be returned for further work. Papers may either be accepted, accepted with revisions, or rejected. It is incumbent upon the author to make necessary changes and submit the final version on a 3.5-in. floppy disk in WordPerfect 5.1. Upon acceptance, the paper will be copyrighted by the Museum.
